Alumni Legacy Scholarship Application

The Alumni Legacy Scholarship is a four-year, renewable scholarship available to the relative of a Boise State alumna or alumnus. Scholarship amount is equal to in-state fees during the fall and spring semesters. It was established by the Boise State Alumni Association in 2004 to celebrate family traditions of attending Boise State University.

Application Minimum Requirements

To be considered for the Alumni Legacy Scholarship, the following requirements must be met:

- Applicants must be a relative of an alumna or alumnus of Boise State University. Individuals who have completed at least 16 credits qualify as alumni of Boise State University.
- Available to incoming freshman only
- Minimum high school GPA of 3.5
- Minimum ACT score of 24 and or a minimum SAT score of 1090
- Must enroll as a full-time fee-paying student
- Completed Essay (no more than 500 words)
Why is becoming a legacy scholar at Boise State University important to you? Describe the distinctive traits that you admire in the family member who attended Boise State University and made you a legacy.

Application Preferences

Applicants are chosen by the Alumni Association Scholarship and Awards Committee. In addition to the minimum requirements set forth above, the Committee gives consideration and preference to the following factors:

- The relative of the applicant graduated (rather than attended without graduating) from Boise State University, Boise State College, or Boise Junior College,
- The relative of the applicant is a parent, grandparent, or great-grandparent (rather than aunt, uncle, sibling, etc.) of an alumna or alumnus of Boise State University, Boise State College, or Boise Junior College,
- The relative of the applicant is a current dues-paying member of the Boise State University Alumni Association, and
- The Committee will place heavy emphasis on the Essay (no more than 500 words).

Ongoing Renewal Requirements

Scholarships awarded are eligible for renewal for up to three additional years if the student maintains the following requirements:

- Full Time Student Status
- 3.25 cumulative GPA
- Participation in the Student Alumni Association, and a member in good standing
- Attendance at Alumni Association Board of Directors meetings and participate on a Board of Directors Committee



Application Checklist

- Completed Application Form (both sides)
- 2 letters of recommendation from high school faculty members
- High school transcript
- Essay - Heavy emphasis placed on the essay (No more than 500 words):
 - Why is becoming a legacy scholar at Boise State University important to you, and describe some traits that you admire in the family member who attended Boise State University and made you a legacy.

Application Deadline is February 16, 2009
All application materials must be received by this date.
